DONATIONS & VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR THE DROP IN CENTER

As a Cathedral, we should be proud of the success of our Thursday Drop In Center! We are getting between 60 and 80 visitors each week and their needs are great. We distribute snacks, coffee, and water as well as toiletry items and clothing to folks who are struggling to meet ends and those who are unhoused. Since March, we have provided our homeless guests with 27 tents and 22 sleeping bags, which we purchase. Consequently, our financial resources have dwindled.

How can you help?

- 1. You can donate funds to the Drop In Center to help pay for the supplies that we distribute!
- 2. You can donate clean new or used clothing, especially sneakers, sandals, jeans, and underwear for both men and women.
- 3. You can volunteer once in a while or on a regular basis. If you want to "ease in" to helping, just come to the Undercroft during our busiest time between 9 and 11 a.m. and we will bring you to the storage room where you can fulfill clothing and supply requests. We will bring you a list and you can look for the items (men's XL t-shirt, ankle socks, shampoo, etc). Then one of us will bring back your finds to the guest.
